Calvary greetings to all our amiable parents.

School Fees: We appreciate our parents who paid their ward(s) school fees promptly. The BMS policy of zero tolerance for fees indebtedness still remains.

PTA Level: PTA levy is also an important fee. It was agreed at the PTA General Meeting that parents are to pay N4, 000 once for a session. This will enable the PTA carry out their projects. (Ignore this if you have paid)

Students' Conduct: Any form of indiscipline in the school will not be overlooked. Parents are to warn their ward(s) against any form of indiscipline and encourage them to obey the school's rules and regulations. (The School frowns at bullying)

Spiritual: Church wears should be black sandals/white shirt (long sleeve)/white trousers for boys with black belt and blue tie while girls are to wear white gowns with black sandal and black berets.

School Wears: Students slim fitting their uniforms won't be tolerated again.

Black Cortina shoes should be bought for both boys and girls on resumption.

Students' Properties: Parents are encouraged to put names on all the items that belong to their ward(s) for easy identification, especially when it is misplaced but not to deface the school uniform.

R.A/G. A Uniforms: Royal Ambassadors and Girls Auxiliary regularly meet on Sunday afternoon. It is now compulsory for all the Boys and Girls (G. A) to have their own uniforms. We encourage the parents to buy the uniform for their ward(s).

Cash/Contraband Items: Students are not to be carrying cash. The cash given to them should be converted to tickets immediately they enter the school through their guardians. Other items like drugs, cosmetics or insecticides should be submitted to the school nurse who will help them to administer it. Students are also not to be in possession of insecticides and antiseptic like Izal, Dettol etc. These items are to be with the school House Mistresses/Masters

Eating Habit: Each student should come with a set of cutlery and a napkin to the school.

Students will not be allowed to borrow spoons from one another. Any student that has misplaced stainless his/her plate & cup brought to school must resume with another set.

Hair cut: Students who cut their hair should come to school with their personal clippers while girls that plait their hair should be given enough money as students will not be allowed to carry the same hairstyle for more than one week.

Health: Kindly treat students for malaria before coming back to school. Encourage your ward(s) to use mosquito nets to prevent mosquito bite which leads to malaria fever.

Items to be brought: Each student is to come with the following: 2 Brooms, one medium Dettol, Harpic and a Jar of insecticide, 2 rolls of tissue paper.

SS 3 Extension: SS3 students will go home briefly on 23/12/2021 and resume on 3/01/2022 to continue with extension classes. Parents are to encourage their ward(s) to be of good conduct during the period.

Sport: Students are expected to come along with their white canvas and white socks for sport on Wednesdays.

Inter-House Sport: This will take place on 23rd February 2022. Students are to pay N3,500 each for the sport wear.

Admission: Admission into JS I — JS2 and SSI - 2 is in progress.

School Resumption: School resumes on 10th January, 2022 from 10:00am — 6:00pm.

Students are expected to bring their bank drafts or other evidences of payment without which they will not be permitted to enter school. The Lord will provide for you.
